



Major Range and Test Facility Base



- > JITC is DOD's only Joint Operational Test Agency (OTA)
- As an OTA, JITC plans, executes, and independently reports on the OT&E of Information Technology Systems to determine the extent that they are Operationally Effective, Suitable, and Survivable (Cyber Security):
 - Effectiveness and Suitability is evaluated through testing performed with typical trained users and support staff exercising and maintaining system capabilities within operationally realistic environments
 - Survivability is evaluated through Cyber Security Cooperative Vulnerability and Penetration Assessments and Adversarial Assessments performed within operational realistic environments



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~ DICE² MISSION ~

To serve as the premier joint interoperability testing venue for certifying IT and NSS in support of rapid acquisition and fielding of net-centric warfighting capabilities.

~ DICE² VISION ~

Enable agile testing in an operationally realistic environment to ensure warfighter dominance in the information domain

~ DICE² INTENT ~

Provide the U.S. Armed Forces and Combatant Commands (CCMDs) with the confidence they need in their IT and National Security Systems so they can focus on fighting the enemy, and not their equipment.
