Knowledge Management (KM)

A discipline focused on integrating people and processes enabled by tools throughout the information lifecycle in order to create shared understanding and increase organizational performance and decision-making.



Knowledge Management and Outcomes Background


- KM is a critical DOD enabling capability.
- DOD components employ KM to produce and foster rapid and meaningful innovation.
- Through KM, and other disciplines we enhance operational effectiveness/efficiency, reduce errors, improve shared understanding, and increase decision making confidence and consistency in direct support of the mission and warfighter.
- KM complements the Secretary of Defense's lines of effort. All DOD activities benefit from shared understanding, improved decisionmaking, enhanced mission/organizational performance, and adaptation that results from a learning organization.















