2007 – COUNCIL PUBLISHED THE NATO INFORMATION MANAGEMENT POLICY (NIMP)

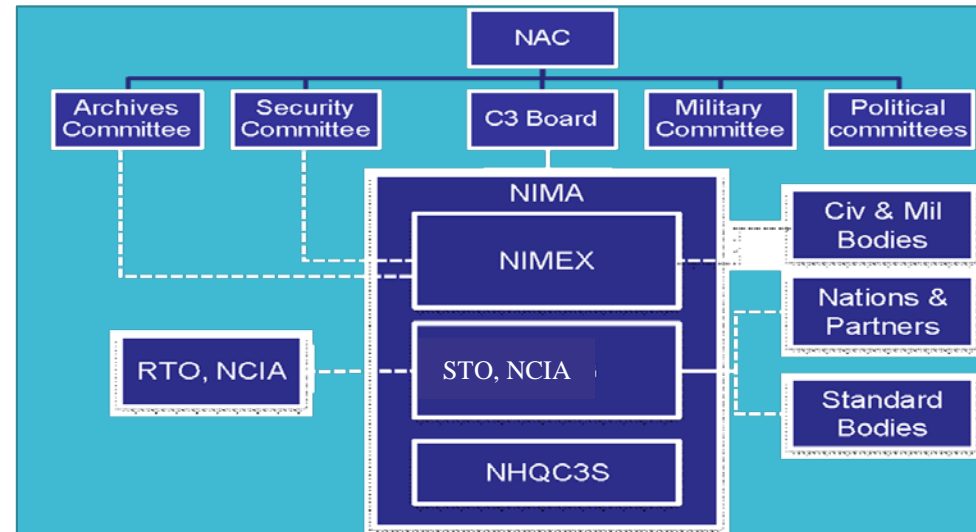


2008 – PRIMARY DIRECTIVE ON INFORMATION MANAGEMENT (PDIM)

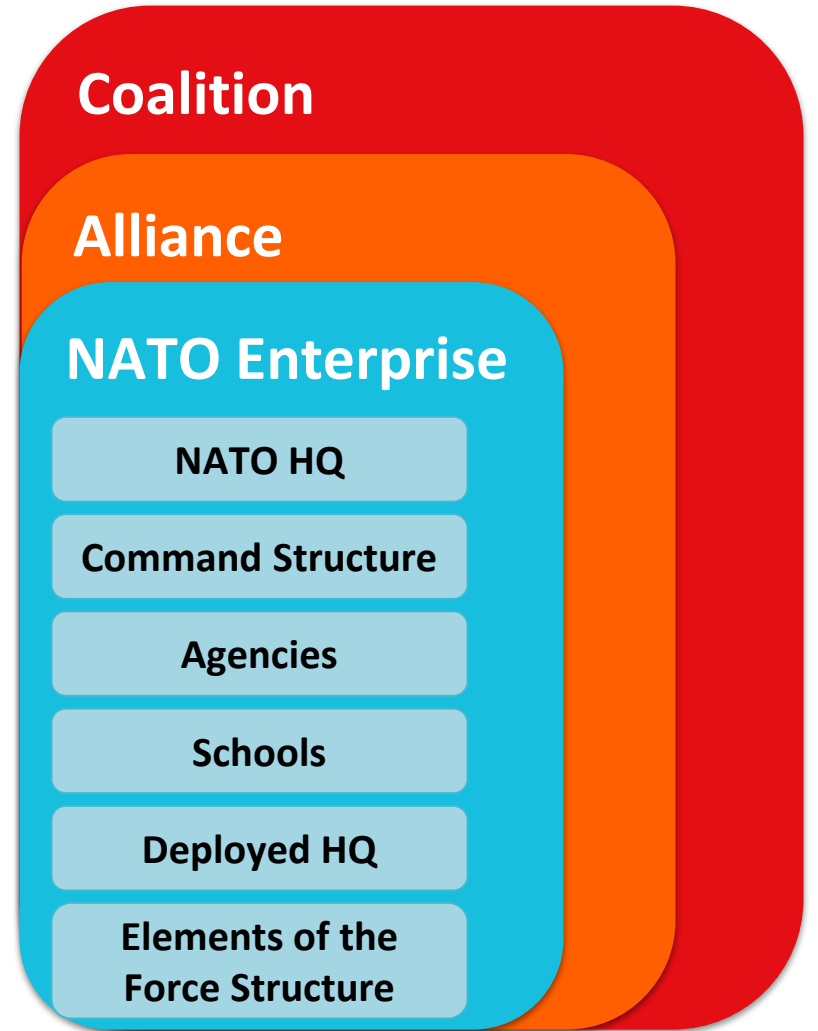

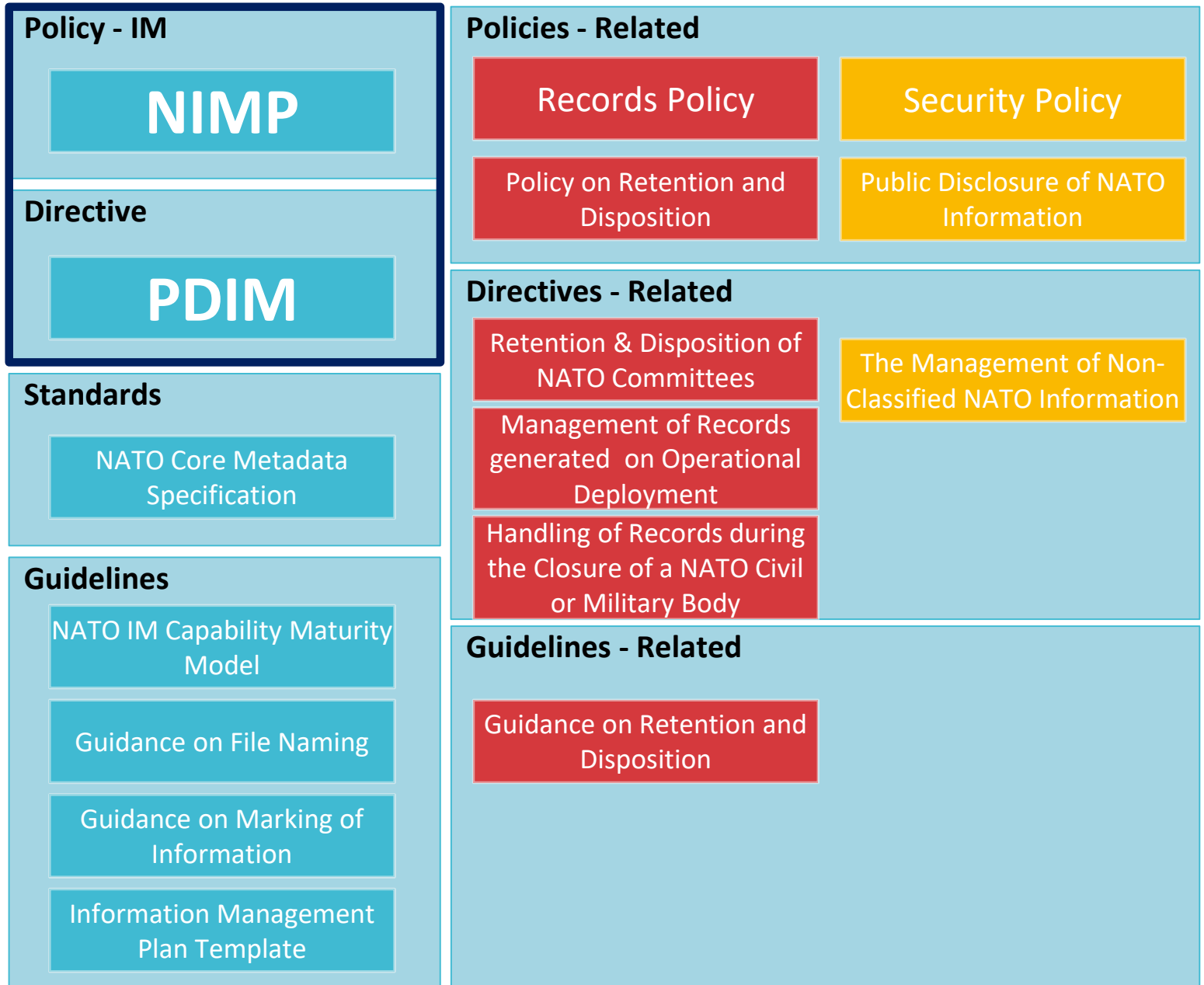

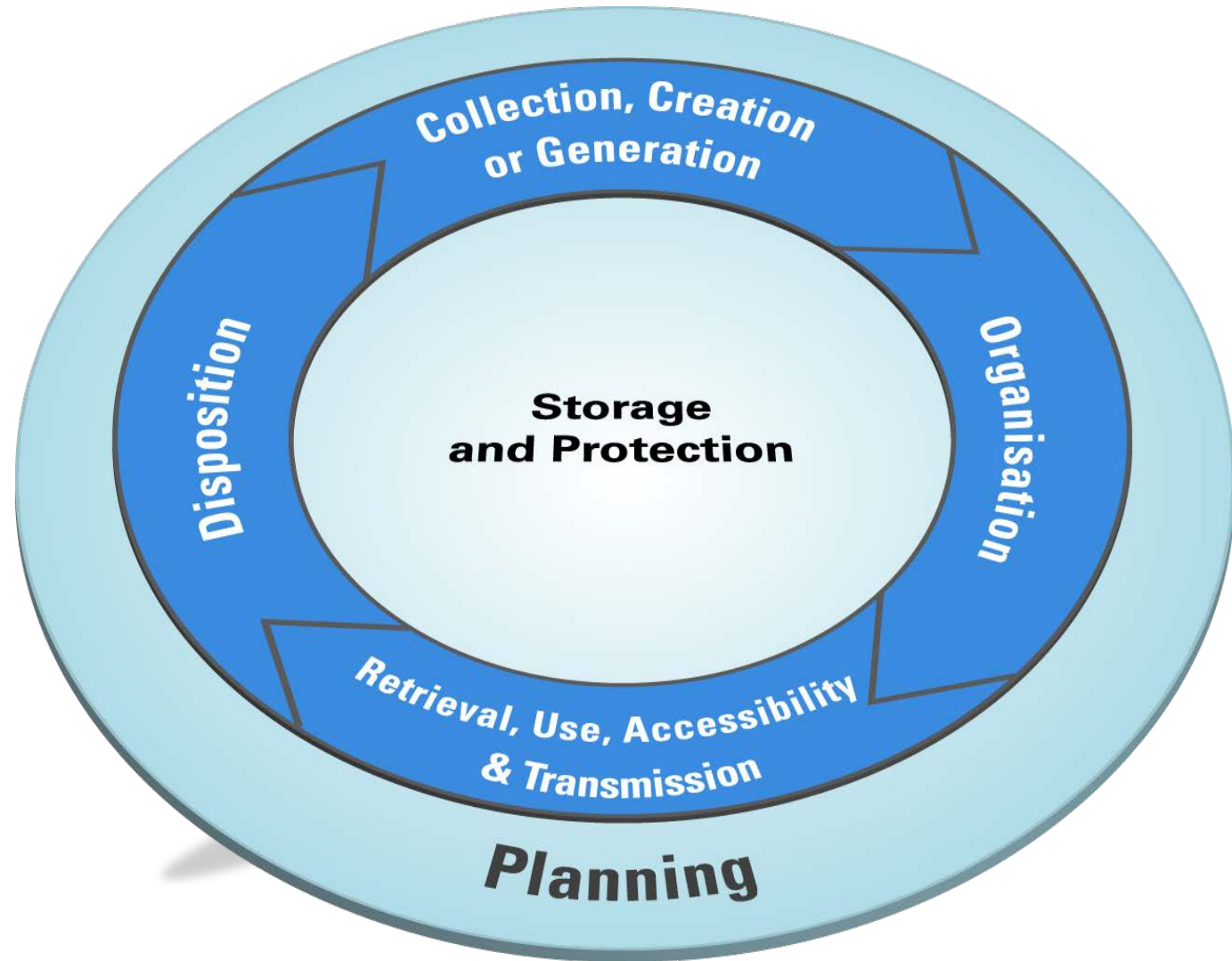

New NIMP: KM Roles and Responsibilities

Heads of NATO civil and military bodies:

- Ensure that policies and directives are complied with;
- Implement organisational and governance structures;
- Apply KM training programmes;
- Adapt infrastructure to a K-centric working environment.
- Appoint a Senior Official for KM implementation.

Knowledge managers:

- Promote a knowledge-sharing culture;
- Advise on KM processes and practices;
- Stimulate and facilitate the knowledge cycle;
- Manage enterprise (business & operational) processes;
- Create and foster a culture of continuous learning;
- Develop or raise KM awareness, education and training.

New NIMP: KM concept

KNOWLEDGE: Facts , information and skills acquired through experience or education; the theoretical or practical understanding of a subject.

KNOWLEDGE MANAGEMENT: A business process that formalizes the management of intellectual assets, enabling effective action through their use
