





New NIMP: Knowledge Management concept New NIMP: KM Roles and Responsibilities Heads of NATO civil and military bodies:

- Ensure that policies and directives are complied with;
- Implement <u>organisational and governance structures;</u>
- Apply <u>KM training programmes;</u>
- Adapt infrastructure to a <u>K-centric working environment</u>.
- Appoint a Senior Official for <u>KM implementation</u>.

Knowledge managers:

- Promote a <u>knowledge-sharing</u> culture;
- Advise on <u>KM processes and practices</u>;
- Stimulate and facilitate the knowledge cycle;
- Manage enterprise (business & operational) processes;
- Create and foster a culture of continuous learning;
- Develop or raise <u>KM awareness</u>, education and training.

### New NIMP: KM concept

**KNOWLEDGE**: Facts , information and skills <u>acquired through experience or education</u>; the theoretical or practical <u>understanding</u> of a subject.

#### <u>KNOWLEDGE MANAGEMENT</u>: A business process that <u>formalizes the management of intellectual</u> <u>assets</u>, enabling effective action through their use
